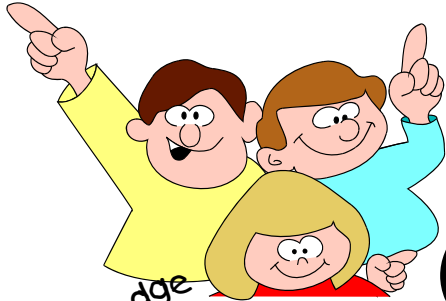




Drug Free Kids

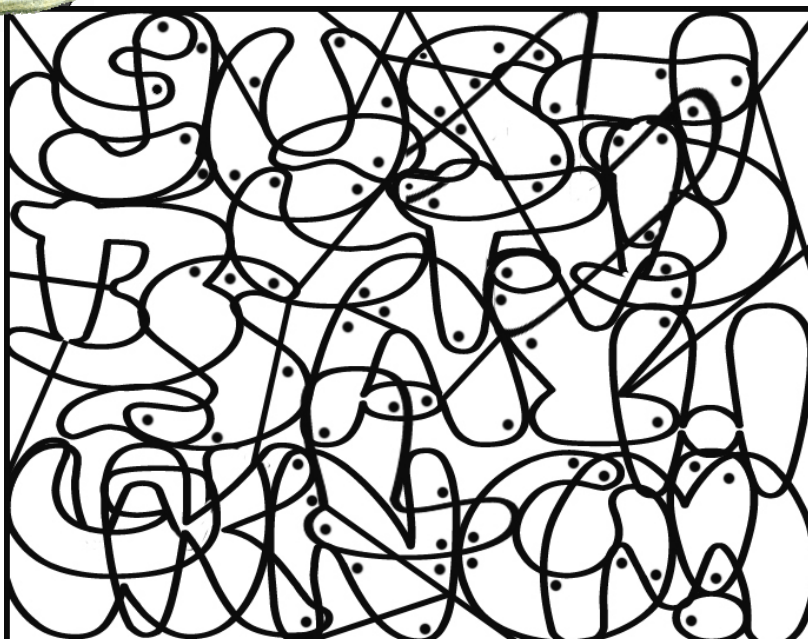

A Promise is a Promise!

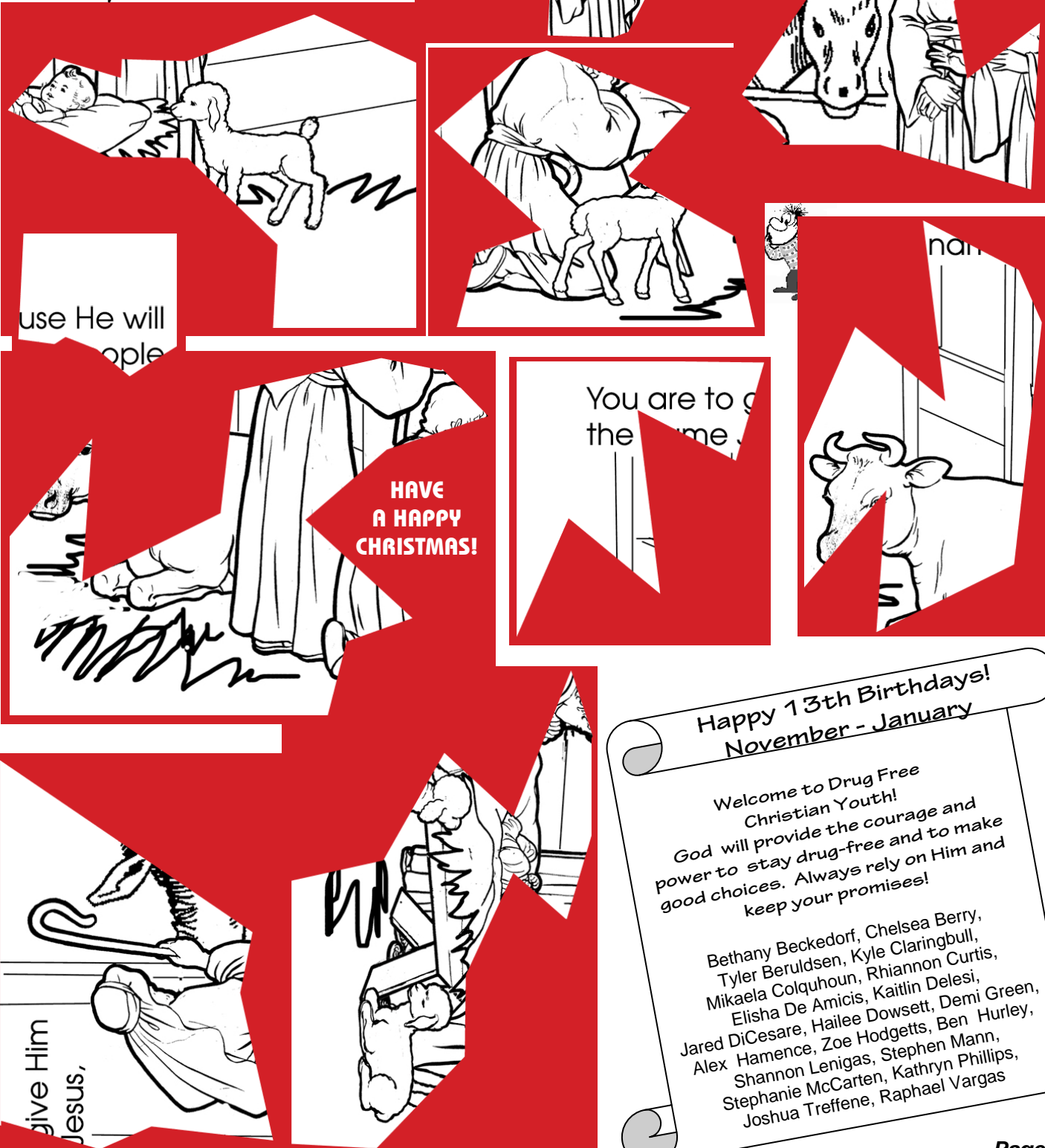
Often times people do not keep their promises or New Year resolutions. But a promise is meant to be kept and God can help you do that.
