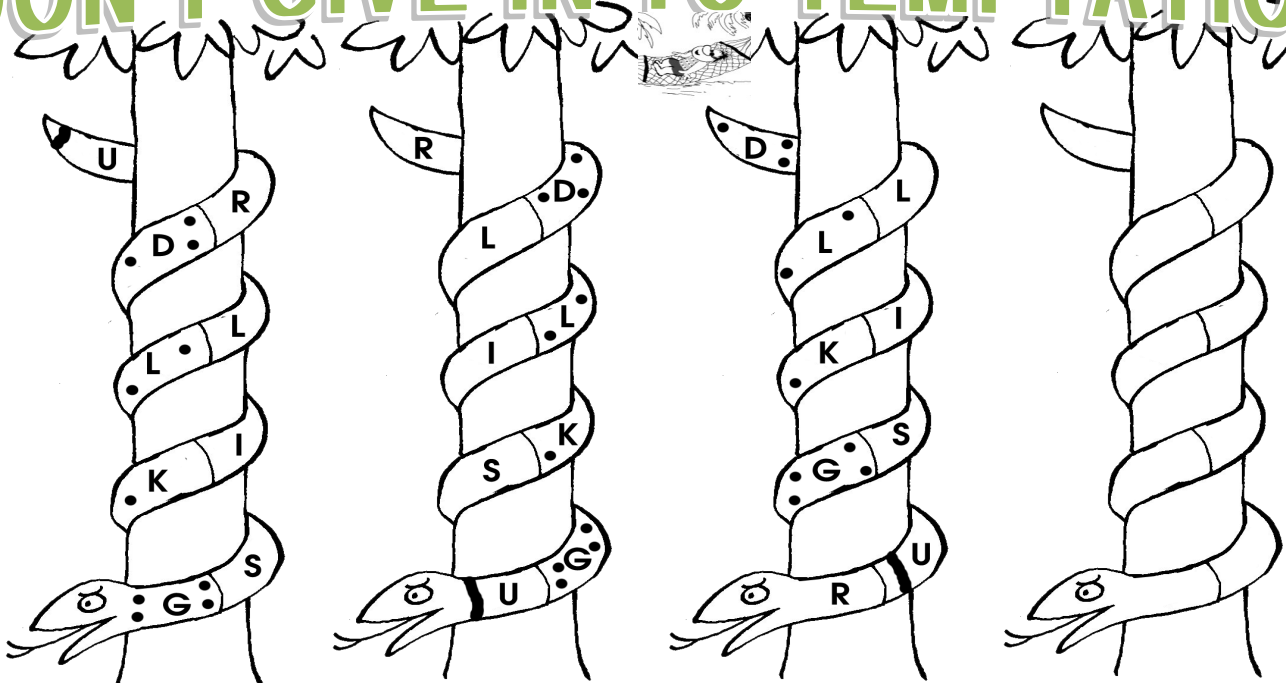

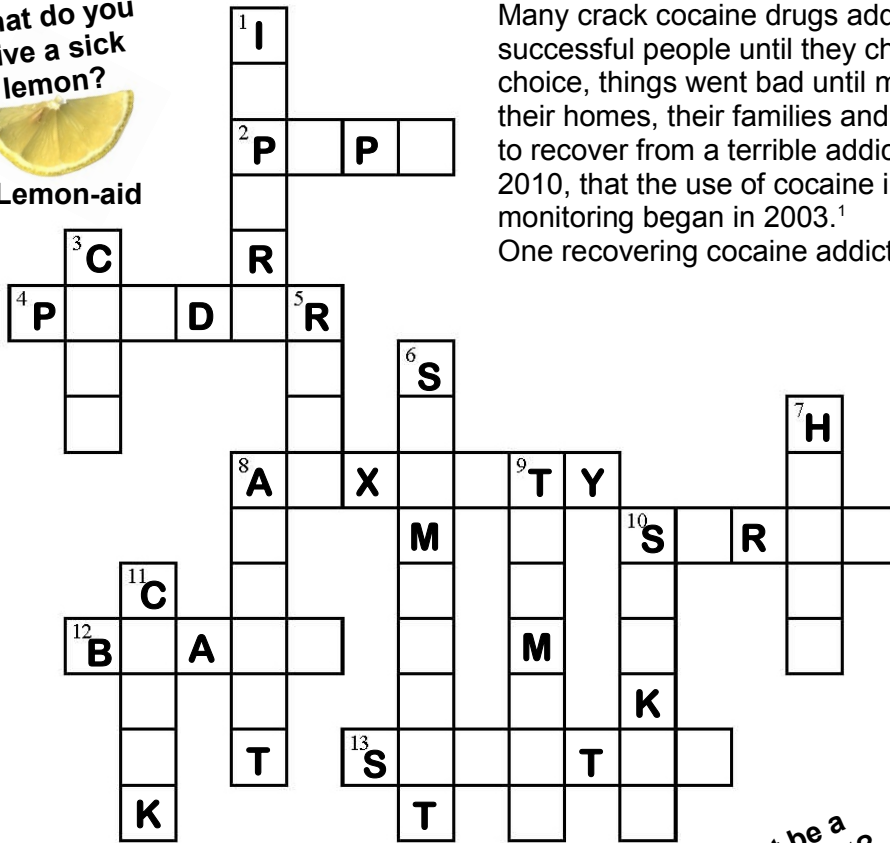


COCAINE RUINS SUCCESS!

Many crack cocaine drugs addicts tell the same story. They were successful people until they chose to try cocaine. From that one choice, things went bad until many of them lost their businesses, their homes, their families and friends and spent many years trying to recover from a terrible addiction. It was reported in October 2010, that the use of cocaine in Australia has doubled since monitoring began in 2003.¹

One recovering cocaine addict says:

"Don't ever try smoking crack cocaine – for any reason.

Crack cocaine is the most addictive substance imaginable. Crack cocaine will take your soul, crack cocaine will take your morals and crack cocaine will take your life.
