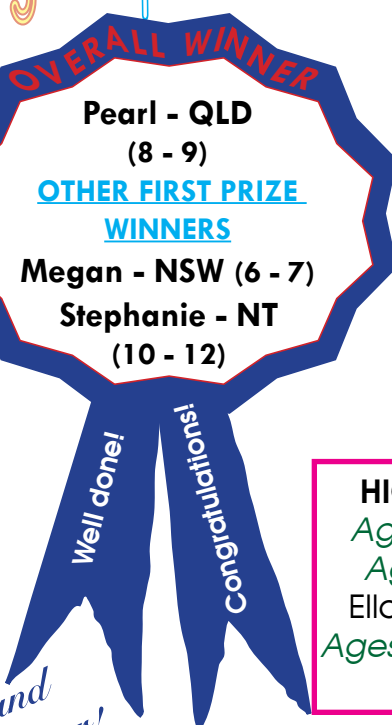

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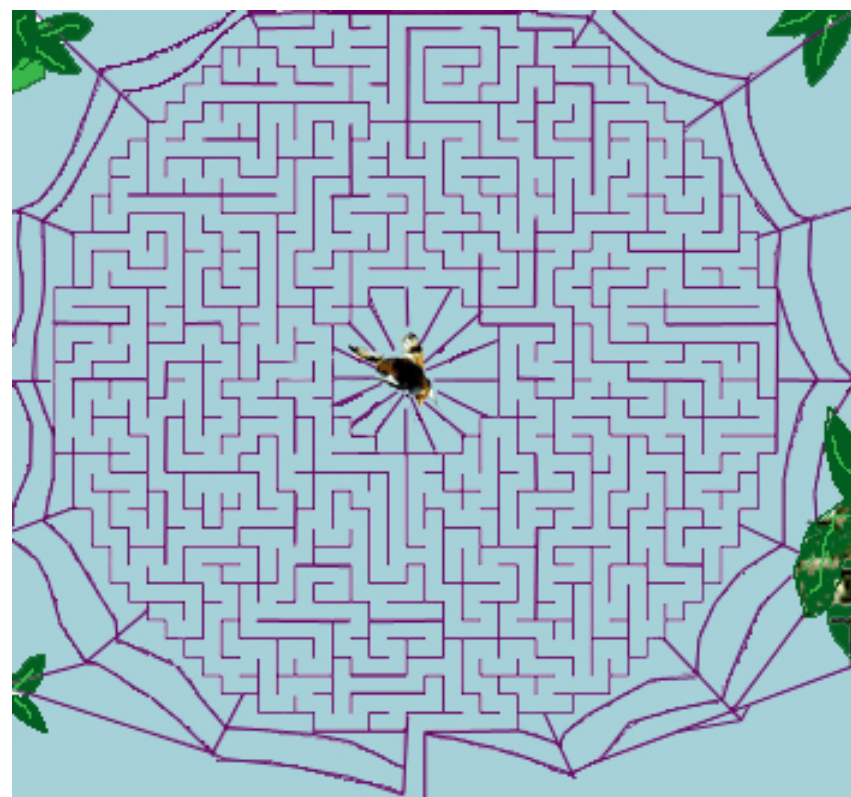

Help the spider to find its way through the maze to the centre of its web to catch the fly.

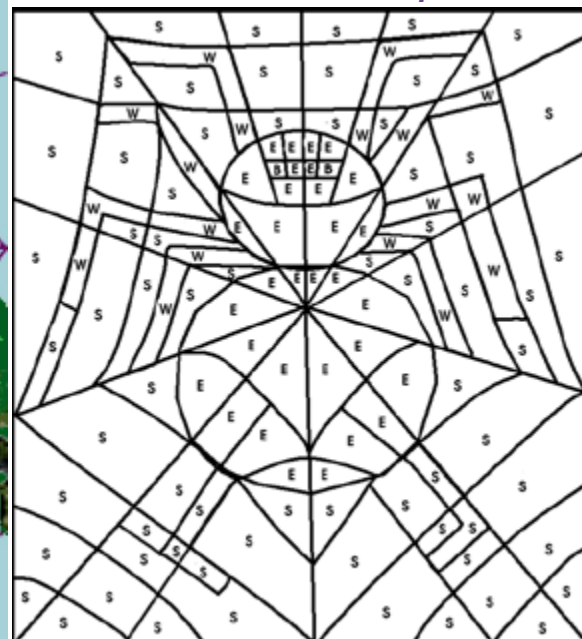
Alcohol, tobacco and other drugs are like spiders' webs. They are a trap, which can look attractive. However, remember that a trap takes its victim captive and causes disease and death.



TRY THIS GAME:
Take a hula hoop and stretch masking tape across it, like the spokes of a spider's web with the tape wrapped around the hoop edges. Hang the hoop on the clothesline or lean against a wall with the sticky side of the masking tape facing you. Take 10 cotton balls and stand 1 metre away and see how many of the cotton balls you throw at the spider's web, get caught. The person with the highest number caught wins. If you don't have a hula hoop, stretch the masking tape between two wooden or plastic chairs, or across a doorway.

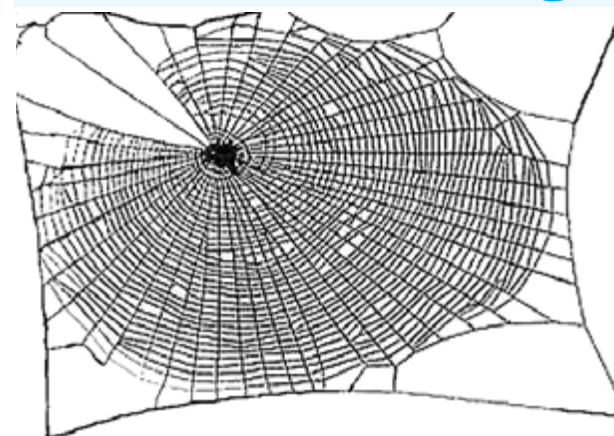

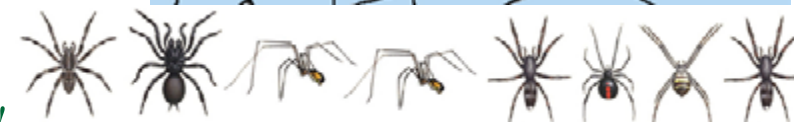
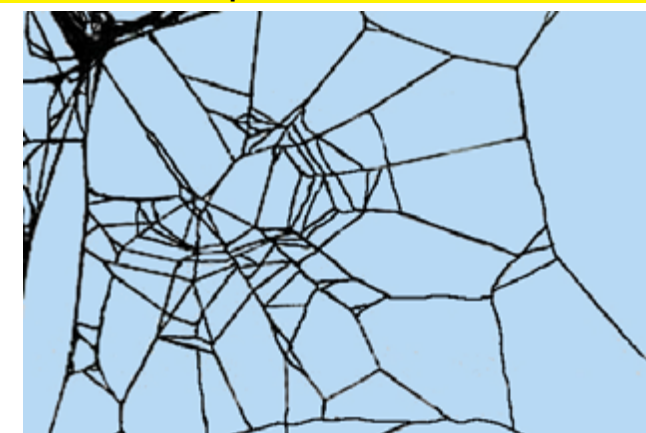


Many **drugs** are **alkaloids** which are **chemical** substances of **plant** origin. The names of these substances often end in "ine". These substances all affect the central nervous system in the body and in certain doses are **poisonous**. Some of these substances include **nicotine**, **strychnine**, **morphine**, **cocaine**, **quinine** and **caffeine**. All of them can cause **health problems**, but some get more attention than others. Caffeine is one drug that is used widely in society. It is found in **coffee**, **coke**, **energy drinks**, **tea** and a little in **chocolate**. These drinks cause people to feel **awake** and **alert** as caffeine is a **stimulant**. It whips up their **nervous system** but as its effects wear off, a person may have withdrawal symptoms such as a **headache**, **tiredness**, **anxiety**, **irritability**, a **depressed** mood and difficulty **concentrating**. Remember that clean **water** is always the **best choice** when choosing what to drink!


